## Event Day Details

As in the previous two years, NE Alberta Street will be officially closed for the Art Hop event. The road closure allows for visiting artists, craftsmen, and food vendors to be placed in the section of the street otherwise used for parking.

The closed section of NE Alberta Street is still being determined. The beginning of the closure and team leader information is subject to change prior to the event:

*There will be four to six stages placed throughout the venue for performing artists ranging from musicians, bands, neighborhood choirs, and spoken word presentations.*

**Each vendor space costs \$50 for artists and \$100 for food vendors. Food vendors, please remember to get your Temporary Restaurant License from Multnomah County at: 503.988.3400. (This is your responsibility to take care of prior to the event.) The assigned space will roughly be a 10' x 12' area. Vendors will need to supply their own tables, materials, and electricity for the event. These reserved spots are for the showing and/or sale of hand-crafted items only and we ask the artist be present. Art Hop prioritizes vending spaces to locally made art and crafts. If you wish to show fair trade, imported art and crafts, please contact us for permission.**

If vendors sign up and pay prior to May 1, 2010, you will be listed in an Art Hop full-page ad distributed by The Portland Mercury. Also if you register before May 1, 2010 you will be able to request your zone preference. All reasonable requests will be accommodated. Your pre-assigned spot and credential will be mailed to you by May 8th. You must have the event credential with you at all times on event day.

Vendor Check-In on event day will be located at 20th and NE Alberta. At check-in vendors will be assigned their area and given credentials to be displayed in their booth for the duration of the event. Vendors are ONLY allowed to set up in their assigned areas and not on the sidewalks nor on the street in front of businesses.
